Eighth Grade to Participate in National Testing

Lowpoint-Washburn 8th grade students have been selected to represent schools across our state and nation by participating in the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP). NAEP is given by the National Center for Education Statistics with the US Department of Education and tells us what our nation's students know and can do in key subject areas. It is the largest continuing and nationally representative assessment and has been providing valid and reliable data on student performance since 1969.

The results of NAEP are published in a report called The Nation's Report Card which provides information about student achievement to educators, parents, policymakers, and the public.

Our 8th grade students will take an exam in mathematics, reading or science on February 23.
